

Parent/Guardian Consent

I/We _____, parent(s) / guardian(s)
of _____ (the "Student"), acknowledge that I/we have read and understand the information provided to us by Pearson College (the "College"), together with the Student's "Acceptance Letter" and "Handbook 10-11".

I/We understand and accept that some programs that the Student will participate in may have inherent risks. I/We also understand that some College approved activities are not held at the College and may involve the Student travelling elsewhere in Canada or to another country and agree that the Student is authorized to participate in these activities. I/We acknowledge that the College would not offer its program without receiving from the Student's parents/guardians this signed consent.

I/We also accept and agree that, during the dates that begin and end the College's academic year(s), the Student is attending the College, the Director shall act as legal guardian for the Student in all matters. This may include the communication of essential medical information about the Student to the Director by Physicians, Nurses, or other Health Care Professionals. I/We accept that in certain situations, the Director may be required to make medical treatment decisions on behalf of the Student. I/We agree that the Director has the authority to make whatever medical treatment decisions the Director believes are required.

I/We expressly confirm that I/We have read and fully understood "Handbook 10-11" which details some of the expectations, rules, and regulations of Pearson College.

I/We further acknowledge that the Student cannot be under constant supervision and may engage in unauthorized and risky behavior. In consideration of the acceptance of Pearson College of the Student, I/We hereby agree to indemnify and save harmless Pearson College, its Directors, Officers, Employees, Volunteers, and Agents from any loss or damage whether to the person or to property, arising from and during the Student's attendance at Pearson College and furthermore release and forever discharge Pearson College its Directors, Officers, Employees, Volunteers, and Agents from any and all actions, causes of actions, claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses and compensation whatsoever which I/We or the Student may hereafter have against Pearson College which arises out of or is connected with, directly or indirectly from the Student's attendance at Pearson College.

I/We also understand that the College collects, uses, and disseminates personal information for a number of College purposes including, but not limited to photographs and videos which may include the Student's image, assessing the Student's academic performance, and the Student's participation in the College, and I/we hereby consent to the collection, use, and dissemination of this personal information by the College.
